## History of the Blocks

From the papers of Jacob Heinrich Block, Editor of Steinbach Post, author of "Gruenthal": The following is taken from : "Die Blocks Sippe" and translated. Quotations are from Abraham Vogt, founder of "Mennonitische Familienforschung" in Steinbach, Manitoba, as indicated.

"Inherited Influence and Characteristics determine more than anything else the Destiny of Humanity". - Goethe.

"That is why this family research shall not be just a dry gathering of names and dates, but it shall breath influence and life, and future generations shall read it with interest. Our predecessors were people, like us, with flesh and blood; they are us themselves.

We require from everyone the following information:

- a. Birth: when? where?
- b. Baptism: when? where?
- c. Marriage: when? where?
- d. Funeral: when? where?
- e. Education and Profession:
- f. Activities engaged in:
- g. Community of his/Her Activities and Life:
- h. Special experience and Maturity:
- i. Charachter Traits:

Of special importance is the last point, in order to determine the concept of what is "a real Block" or "ein echter Block", and in which person of this family these characteristics are most clearly and fully drawn into the forefront, and wherein they are evident.

Abram Vogt writes further: "In our family during the passing of time the following had become clear in regards to what a real Block is: One imagined him to be a corpulent person, not taller than medium height, dark complexion, obvious , dark lively eyes. Characteristically, very active and undertaking, with a singular opinion, self-conscious, demanding his outlook and rights. Closely associated, therefore to being a "hot-tempered block" or "dolla Block". For example, it is known, that the dark skin and black hair do not come from our great grandfather Peter Block, but far more from the maternal side; or better said, this feature was brought in from the mother-in-law of our first family-father Peter Block.

Although it can not be proven that she descended from the Gypsies, but her black eyes and hair, and also her loveliness were astonishing to behold. Her maiden name was Aganetha Quiring. As a young woman she came with her husband Johann Bartel from Prussia to Russia and became the mother of our great-grandmother Maria Block nee Bartel.

Abram Vogt writes in regards to his relatives as follows: In our families, that is in the family of David (6) and Abram (8) Block, the type "Block" appears in the following persons: With every uncle and aunt there appear definite characteristics of the family, and as such come into the foreground; the most with uncle David Block, the least with uncle Abram Block. From the Aunts the type was evident most with Aunt Quiring, aunt Katharina. With the nieces and nephews we begin with the oldest. The family Vogt - Aganetha Block - from ten children, there were just three which showed this type: Aganetha, Katharina, and Johann; the most with Katharina - Frau A. Dyck. With the grandchildren, which had the influence of other families, the "Block" disappears even more. Only with Hans Vogt's children, the twins, Hans and Ewald, the type again appears clearly.

For the predecessors of Peter Block, so writes Abram Vogt, we possess no dates. But there exists only the following information, as H.H. Peters, Chilliwack, B.C. points out in "Der Bote", Apr. 20, 1965, p.3. "I was once told, that at the time of the first immigration, Block brothers went to Russia. For one it became "grey", and he returned to Germany, the second went down under the Russian folk and became lost to Mennonitism. He is supposed to be a predecessor of Alexander Block, who in 1918 famished in Petersburg. The third was Peter Block, who was a second minister in Kronsgard. From him descend all Mennonite "Blocks" in Russia.

When great grandfather Peter Block came to Russia from Prussia is unknown. He was a tailor in Kronsgart, later a farmer. He was also a minister of the Kronsweider Church in Kronsgart. The parents

of the great grandmother Maria Block nee Bartel, were Johannes Bartel and Aganetha Quiring. This couple came in 1797 from Prussia to Russia and lived in Kronsgart. Great-great-grandfather became a minister here by election.

These eight children were raised as one family in the village of Kronsgart. The grandparents have lived together yet a long time. They celebrated their silver anniversary, and all children were married. - After the death of mother Anna Dick, nee Zacharias, Father Dick married August 1906 a widow, Mrs. Loewen.

Mother Loewen had eight children of her first marriage, the oldest were married; the youngest four she brought to Kronsgart: Olga, David, Hans and Kolja.

I remember well the day when I asked my mother: "What kind of a woman did my grandfather Peter Block have as his first wife?" And she replied: "the old "Grandmas" sister." The old "Grandma" was fathers grandmother. She had been a widow thirty years, and has lived with her children, our grandparents, who lived at Wiesenfeld. Thus we had one grandmother, father's mother, and one great-grandmother, the old 'Grandmother' so called to differentiate. She was Aganetha Bartel from Moerensee"(?). Mrs. Heinrich ..... and her sister Maria Bartel, was the first wife of grandfather Peter Block, nee Maria Bartel from Moewsen.

In the possession of the "old Grandma", Aganetha Bartel, Mrs. Heinrich Plennert, was a small booklet, or a scribbler. It had a nice binding with colored flowers. On each page beautiful flowers were drawn; there were also written verses. People said, this the "old Grandma" had drawn herself for her father Johann Bartel during the journey from Prussia to Russia.

Brief Biographical Notes on the Foregoing FamilyPeter Block: (Al-B1)

He was the oldest of my fathers brothers; him, the others , and also the sisters, except Mrs. Wiebe, I have all known well. He always grew a full beard. He was a blacksmith. He worked in the facory of Johann Froese in Gruenfeld. The marriage was childless. He possessed a nice house in the so-called "nwohnerreihe. He lived like his wife, into old age.

David Block: (Al-B3)

He remained single and died in the home of my brothers at the turn of the century. He was a carpenter. He has however, operated a business, not known to me in the city of Wilna for a time. Later he lived with my parents.

He also experienced the following: Horse rustling was at that time in Russia a widespread misfortune for its people. A Jew named Zobol, led such a rustler-gang. He was once brought hand-cuffed to Gruenfeld. Some young muscular men were asked to watch him. Among these was also uncle David Block and a Abram Penner. I have never quite understood what happened then, just one thing I do know. For Zobol, the Jew, the matter became too great. In an unmindful moment, when he was not watched, he pulled out a big knife, and tossed it about himself. He was not able to flee, but he tore open Uncle Davids stomach, yet without, as it later turned out, damaging his insides, and thrust the knife into Abram Fenner's ankle. He caught the Jew by the beard and kept him. Mu uncle was loaded on a carriage very carefull, with a bowl on the side, in which were hung his insides; in this way he was brought to the hospital in Sofijewka. Repeatedly, we children were able to go along to visit him in the hospital. How long he lay there, I don't know anymore. I just know he became well again and lived for a number of years yet.

Jacob Block: (Al-B9)

was the youngest of the brothers. When he was among the first who were called into the "Forstdienst", he had promised to marry a girl. After the service, probably during this time, he broke his given promise, found a different girl and was married to her. For the disappointed one it was somewhat too much; in he sorrow she called or swore unhappiness for the marriage of the unfaithful. Do we care yet today about a promise made? God says: "repay your promise to the mightiest." This marriage bore six or seven children, but all died

in early childhood, and also the woman died in her best years.

He came to his senses and the uncle repented; also made a promise: never on Sunday to have breakfast, and thereby to curb the consequence of that wish. The uncle has not broken his promise. + have later worked many a season in his business. With a question I looked up, when after morning meditation he left the table. Many years passed by till I learned to know the explanation for this unusual action. God reckoned with his promise. The uncle again married, Tina Penner. Out of this marriage, if I do not err, four children were born, and all are alive today, some in B.C. He himself was torn to death in Russia by a bloodhound, ordinanced by the Communists. He was a minister. He reached an age of over 80 years. He lived in Nr. 8 Sagradowka.

Susanna Block: (Al-B4)

She became Mrs. Peter Paetkau from Einlage. How she came to know her husband? Here is the story. In Einlage lived three brothers: Johann, Peter and Franz Paetkau, all single, and took care of their farming together, lived together, while a hired maid took care of the household. Now happened the accident. What now? It should and must be found a replacement, and all efforts seemed in vain. Then someone made them aware of the young girl Susanna Block in Kronsweide. It lay not far to the north on the Dniepr River. Full of joy and with new hope to encourage Peter starts out to Kronsberg. But this also seemed in vain. Yet when Peter begged the reason for the refusal, it came somewhat shamefully from the lips of the other-wise quick to speak girl: "Peter, not for a few months, then people just talk, why not forever?" This is what Peter wanted, and rejoiced, he continued to insist, but now already "till death do us part". Mr. Julius Block indicated that he went back alone once, but soon they had the wedding, and a wonderful family life developed. Of the children there lives yet a widow Reimer in Canada, nee Margarethe Paetkau.

Maria Block: (Al-B5)

Maria became Mrs. Johann Paetkau in Mjoradowka. There exists no relation between Peter Paetkau and Johann Paetkau. There existed a healthy visitation between my parents and these Paetkaus. I do

not know exactly how many, it may be ten to twelve children out of this family, which all went to Siberia.

Agatha Block: (Al-B8)

became Mrs. Peter Wiebe. This family has remained entirely strange to me. I just know from hearing and talking that uncle Peter liked liquor.

Katarina Block: Al-B6)

She became Mrs. Abram Wyck. Once they lived in Alexefeld. These must have been somewhat affluent, because I am told the following story: She married a widower, Abram Wyck. He must have been somewhat older than she. Her neighbourhood has asked her for the reason of the "unusual marriage", as she could elect differently. She has replied: "The dear God has permitted me to take the nicest and straightest walking stick out of the hedge of mulberries, presupposedly. There by a search in the hedge and that to take the last branch without thought. I have gone along the hedge, found none which I liked, and at the end of the hedge stood this Abram Wyck." Thus far for the story.

Jacob von Kampen was the son of Heinrich von Kampen #4 Jasekowo. Father came from Eichenfeld #4 and worked in the mill of Jacob Niebuhr in Schoenwiese. Here he married the oldest daughter of Rev. Andreas Vogt. The marriage was of a brief duration: 9 months, 21 days. His son was only 5 days old. Mother remained a widow to her death in the home of her family. She worked many years in the dry goods store 1902-1914.

When her mother came with seven brothers and sisters to Canada, she remained alone in Russia, because of her son, who had married in that year, 1923.

She managed to make it during the war years, revolution and communist regime with various types of work and selling things in a small way. Finally she was secretary for the barbershop.

The most difficult time was when her son Jacob was taken from his wife and small son on Sep. 5, 1937. In 1943 she fled with her daughter-in-law to Germany and came to Canada in 1948.

She remained single, but a biographical note is significant.

Because the idea was then held that daughters had to be satisfied with the six year public school education, Maria had to be happy to help at home after this time. Only when she was 28 years father allowed that she could go to Germany to be trained as a nurse.

Through false information she arrived at Berlin in a Bible School. After she was here a year, she came to Weissbaden into the state hospital, where she got her Red Cross nurses training. In the mean time the war had broken out and she was appointed as a nurse in Germany and had to attend the wounded and sick soldiers. During the war she returned to Russia yet. Here she helped in the Bethania Institute. After she made her exams as a nurse in Russia, she went to Chortitza as a nurse, then in various hospitals in Saporogsche, till her immigration to Canada in 1923.

At once there was no call for nurses, and she had to do house-work. For a time she attended the sick in private homes. In 1928 she founded with her brother the first hospital in Steinbach, Man. After the founding, she worked in the same from 1936-38.. Then she founded the Invalid Home in Steinbach, again with her brother Abram Vogt, where she worked from 1938-1945. When the Invalid Home was moved to Winnipeg, she overtook the leadership of the old and new Invalid Home, Bethania, which she has done till her last days. She worked to her last day, and was taken to Concordia Hospital where in nine hours she died.

From Nieder-Chortitza she went to Nikolaipol, where she not only led the Kindergarten, but taught young girls in the art of Kindergarten leadership.

In 1923 she immigrated with mother and members of the family. Here she founded a Kindergarten and led it from 1923 to 1938. Since 1937 she has led the Kindergarten in North Kildonan. She has taught Sunday School and in the German Saturday Evening School very actively.

During the revolution he happened to be in the home of millowner J.J.Thiessen, Yekaterinoslav , where his oldest sister, Mrs. von Kampen took care of the household, when the Machno bands came into Yekaterinoslav and also to the home of the wealthy millowner. As the men of the house had already vanished, they took all male persons and brought them into a big school where they were court-marshalled. Thus David Vogt was led away.

Without being able to make a plea they were condemned to death by being placed against the wall to be shot.

David said later, that the death was terrible. Now he was to experience it himself, and it has never been so awful as when he faced the death, standing against the wall. But all of a sudden there was a voice to be heard: "Hold it". A Jewish boy advanced upon him and asked: "Are you not the Popen son from Alexandrowsk?" It was a jewish boy out of the home town; he had recognized David, and his father Andreas Vogt. That is why he called David "Popensohn". The jewish boy witnessed for David and thus set him free.

Davids sister Neta, Mrs. von Kampen, had seen him leave. In her searching prayer she made a promise that she would always fast on Friday as long as she would live, if her brother would be released. She has kept her promise, and every Friday from dawn to dusk has never taken a meal.

In 1923 we immigrated with our two year old Leonard. During the voyage our second son was born, as we left the boundary. Aug. 30 we came to Giroux, Manitoba. We lived 15 years in the province. In Manitoba our two other sons were born. 1938 we went to Ontario where we became fruit gardeners till 1956 when we retired to St. Catharines. Now we wanted to live peacefully in retirement, when before two years had passed my beloved husband became ill and his end on earth came on June 25, 1958. Thus the evening of life has approached and in retrospect I must say: It has been work and pain, but it has been dear. One has many reasons to be grateful and therefore the motto on the road of life which has ever existed for me, from the last verses of Psalm 50: "Who sacrifices, He praises Me, and there is the Way, where I show him the grace of God."




